



Official 2025 Series Rules & Class Break Down

- All machines <u>must</u> pass tech inspection and must be in safe working order. No missing lug nuts, cutter pins, or any other fasteners.
- ☑ All machines <u>must have</u> working front and rear brakes. Bikes only need rear brakes.
- All machines <u>must have front, rear, and right side (facing outside of the track)</u> number plates. If you do not have one and don't get scored properly that is on you. Number plates <u>must</u> be readable and visible. We have number plates for you to buy at the track in the office.
- ✓ Tether switches are <u>required</u> on all <u>quads except</u> classes that state so in the class breakdown (such as Pee Wee and Super Pee Wee). Bikes do not need them.
- Nerf bars are <u>required</u> on all quads unless stated in class breakdown (such as Pee Wee and Super Pee Wee).
- Absolutley NO pit riding without a helmet (especially for minors)
- Restarts will be at the <u>flaggers discretion</u>.
 - In the event of a restart before the first lap is complete all machines will be lined up on the starting line except for the rider or riders who caused the restart, who will be lined up in the back row.
 - In the event of a restart after the first lap is complete all machines will be lined up single file (not staggered) with no more than 5 feet separating the front and rear of each machine.
- ✓ All riders <u>must</u> have proper safety gear:
- Helmet
- Eye Protection
- Boots above the ankles (no tennis shoes)
- Gloves
- Chest Protectors
- Neck Protector





All riders will abstain from alcohol or recreational drug use before and during races. Any rider visibly under the influence will be disqualified from points that day and removed from the track.

Be in staging 3 classes ahead of your race, we will not wait for anyone. If you are having trouble getting your machine started you can send someone to staging to request a 2 minute grace period, (you will be timed) after that we must move on in order to stick to the schedule.

Have a good attitude! If you are having a problem, please be sure to keep your cool when bringing it to the attention of a race official. If you come up with a reasonable attitude, we will do everything in our power to try to resolve the situation. Keep in mind that in almost any case, the race will not be re-ran. We have a great team of flaggers, announcers, stagers, and score keepers that work together to make calls that they see fitting and the official does their best to try to see as much as possible.

✓ No cutting the barrels or tires. We understand things can happen but we will be watching for those who intentionally cut the track and we will disqualify accordingly.

☑ In the event of an accident, nobody is allowed on the track until all racing has stopped and the ambulance has arrived.

All machines must have flat track type tires (such as Hoosier tires) except when noted in the class breakdown (classes such as Pee Wee, Super Pee Wee, Junior Bike, Adult 90, ETC)

All machines must fit through the width gauge during tech inspection and be a max of 50" wide through the events.

☑ Superstock 90 will be visually tech'd for shocks, etc.

☑ No warming up tires or burnouts at the starting line. Please do it at the second row line.


Dangerous pit riding will not be tolerated - dangerous riders will be subject to removal from the race/track.

✓ Staff only is allowed in the clubhouse/office.





- ✓ Teardowns-done at the end of each race day
- \$250 for all classes (\$50 to tech and \$200 to protestee if found legal)
- If you are going to pay for someone to tear down, you will also be torn down.
- ✓ Weather contingencies
- If we make it to intermission and then rained out races are done and points will go off the heats
- If we do not make it to intermission and get rained out, races will be continued the following day.
- Bumpers
- No brush type, tube size may not exceed 1.25" diameter.

Class Breakdown

(Classes are in running order)

1. Heavy Metal Quad Oval

- Any quad
- Rider must weigh a minimum of 265ibs
- We may check weight at the day of event
- 80% cash payback

2. Super Pee Wee Quad Oval

- Ages 8 and under
- 0-60cc 2 stroke or 70cc 4 stroke
- Machines must be stock except gearing, jetting, tires/wheels
- No factory race quads
- Trophy Class

3. Quad C Oval

- Any quad
- May run knobby tires or flat track type tires
- Must have nerf bars and working tether switch
- No pro, B, or A class riders
- No hybrids
- Trophy class

4. Super Pee Wee Bike Oval

- Ages 8 and under
- 0-60cc 2 stroke or 0-70cc 4 stroke
- Machines must be stock except gearing, tires/wheels, and jetting

- No pipes or other engine modifications
- Knobby tires are allowed
- Trophy class

5. Junior 400 Quad Oval

- Ages 15 and under
- 0-225cc 2 stroke or 0-400cc 4 stroke





- Air cooled 2 strokes allowed up to 249cc
- Machines can be modified
- Must have working tether and nerf bars
- Knobby tires are allowed
- No pro class riders
- Trophy class

6. Pee Wee Quad B Oval

- Ages 12 and under
- 0-90cc limit, the polaris outlaw 110 is allowed to run this class
- No Pee Wee Quad A class riders allowed (this class is for less experienced Pee Wee class riders and GFI officials reserve the right to transfer riders and points to the A class at our discretion.)
- Gearing, tires/wheels, and jetting are the only modifications allowed
- Absolutely no modifications allowed to any part of the exhaust including removing baffles
- Knobby tires are allowed, no factory race quads
- Trophy class

7. 30+ Quad Oval

- Any quad
- Rider must be 30 years of age or older on the date of the event

- 80% cash payback

8. Junior Bike Oval

- Ages 15 and under
- 0-85cc 2 stroke or 0-150cc 4 stroke
- Knobby tires are allowed
- Trophy class

9. Quad B Oval

- Any quad
- No pro, C, or A class riders allowed

10. Improved Stock 90cc Quad Oval

- Ages 12 and under
- 0-90cc 2 stroke or 0-125cc 4 stroke
- Factory race quads, such as Apex, DRR, and Cobra must remain stock, with the
 exception of gearing, swaybar, tires/wheels, and any clutching combination may
 be utilized using stock components (any roller/spring combination), coils will be
 checked randomly

11. Pro Quad Oval

- Any quad, any motor
- Pro-am riders allowed
- 100% cash payout (more money may be added if advertised)

12. Women's Quad Oval

- Any quad
- Must be a female (no identifying allowed)
- 80% cash payback

13. Pee Wee Quad A Oval

- Ages 12 and under (this class is for more experienced Pee Wee riders)
- No Pee Wee B riders allowed
- 0-90cc limit
- Gearing, tires/wheels, and jetting are the only modifications allowed
- Absolutely no modifications allowed of any part of the exhaust, including removing baffles
- Knobby tires are allowed
- No factory race quads
- Trophy class

14. Vet Quad Oval

- Any quad
- Any rider 40 years of age or older at date of event
- Money class





15. Outlaw Mini Quad Oval

- Ages 12 and under
- Any quad 0-100cc 2 stroke or 0-150cc 4 stroke
- Machines can be modified in any way but must have nerf bars and working

tether switch

- Flat track tires allowed
- Trophy class

16. Open Bike Oval

- Any bike
- Any rider
- Knobby tires or flat track tires are allowed
- 80% cash payback

17. Junior 300 Quad Oval

- Ages 15 and under
- 0-200cc 2 stroke or 0-300cc 4 stroke
- No hybrids allowed
- Machines can be modified
- Knobby tires are allowed
- No pro class riders
- Machines must have working tether and nerf bars

- Any 2 stroke quad, any cc 2 stroke
- Any 440cc 4 strokes are allowed
- Hybrids allowed

21. Heavy Metal Quad TT

- Any quad
- Rider must weigh a minimum of 265ibs
- We may check weight at the day of event
- 80% cash payback

22. Super Pee Wee Quad TT

- Ages 8 and under
- 0-60cc 2 stroke or 70cc 4 stroke
- Machines must be stock except gearing, jetting, tires/wheels

- No pipes or other engine modifications
- Trophy class

26. Junior 400 Quad TT

- Ages 15 and under
- 0-225cc 2 stroke or 0-400 4 stroke
- Air cooled 2 strokes allowed up to 249cc
- Machines can be modified Must have working tether and nerf bars
- Knobby tires are allowed
- No pro class riders
- Trophy class

27. Pee Wee Quad B TT

- Ages 12 and under
- 0-90cc limit, the polaris outlaw 110 is allowed to run this class
- No Pee Wee Quad A class riders allowed (this class is for less experienced Pee Wee class riders and GFI officials reserve the right to transfer riders and points to the A class at our discretion.)
- Gearing, tires/wheels, and jetting are the only modifications allowed
- Absolutely no modifications allowed to any part of the exhaust including removing baffles

 be utilized using stock components (any roller/spring combination), coils will be
 checked randomly

- 100% cash payout (more money may be added if advertised)

33. Women's Quad TT

- Any quad
- Must be a female (no identifying allowed)
- 80% cash payback

- Trophy class

37. Open Bike TT

- Any bike
- Any rider
- Knobby tires or flat track tires are allowed
- 80% cash payback

38. Junior 300 Quad TT

- Ages 15 and under
- 0-200cc 2 stroke or 0-300cc 4 stroke
- No hybrids allowed
- Machines can be modified
- Knobby tires are allowed
- No pro class riders

40.2 Stroke / 400cc 4 Stroke Quad TT

- Any 440cc 4 strokes are allowed
- Hybrids allowed
- No destroked / debored 450's

41. Pee Wee Bike TT

- Ages 12 and under
- 0-65cc 2 stroke or 0-125cc 4 stroke
- Machines can be modified in any way as long as they do not exceed the displacement rules

- Trophy class

42. Open Pit Bike TT

- Any PIT bike
- Any rider
- No age limit
- 80% Cash Payback

43. Adult 90 Quad TT

- Any rider 18 years or older
- Any 90cc or smaller 4 stroke, or 80cc or smaller 2 stroke
- No factory race quads
- All machines must be stock
